<p>An ex-post evaluation of the Community Initiative INTERREG III 2000 – 2006 was performed by a consortium of partners led by Panteia BV. The ex-post evaluation of Interreg III comprises a number of tasks interactively and iteratively linked. One of the tasks is the in-depth evaluation of a sample of sixteen Interreg III programmes from all three strands, A, B and C. The project was implemented by a consortium led by Pantea while other members of the consortium were: EureConsult (Luxemburg), Policy Research and Consultancy (Germany), GÉPHYRES EURL (France), The Radboud University (The Netherlands)</p> <p>Oikos performed a detailed ex-post evaluation of the INTRERREG IIIA programme Italy – Slovenia according to the methodology developed by the Core Evaluation Team of the project: the team reviewed programme documents such as CIP, Programme Complement, annual reports, evaluation reports, extracts from the databases etc., and conducted interviews with the Managing Authority, Technical Secretariat and several project beneficiaries.</p> <p>The programme was very specific because it was partly (until 2004) run as a combination of ERDF/PHARE funds and as a complete ERDF fund after Slovene accession to the EU.
