<p>A strategic environmental impact assessment (SEA) is being conducted for the Detailed Spatial Plan on the four identified hydropower projects (HPPs) along the Morača River in Montenegro. The SEA will look, among other things, into the downstream impact on Skadar/Shkodra Lake which is a cross-border national park on the border between Montenegro and Albania. The SEA will be part of the decision-making process and as the basis for a detailed Spatial Plan for the same area that will be conducted in parallel with the SEA by another consultant.
